TORONTO, Canada – March 30, 2023 – Mitsubishi Tanabe Pharma Canada, Inc. (MTP-CA), a subsidiary of Mitsubishi Tanabe Pharma America, Inc. (MTPA) is pleased to announce the company has entered into negotiations with the pan-Canadian Pharmaceutical Alliance (pCPA) for RADICAVA® Oral Suspension (edaravone) for the treatment of patients with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS). "This is an important milestone in our quest to secure reimbursement for RADICAVA® Oral Suspension under all publicly funded drug plans in Canada," said Atsushi Fujimoto, President, MTP-CA. "We would like to thank the pCPA and member jurisdictions for their engagement and consideration to add RADICAVA® Oral Suspension to their respective plans."

RADICAVA® Oral Suspension has received positive recommendations from the <u>CADTH</u> <u>Canadian Drug Expert Committee (CDEC)</u> and the <u>Institut national d'excellence en santé et en services sociaux (INESSS)</u> for the treatment of patients with ALS. MTP-CA is continuing to work closely with stakeholders to make RADICAVA® Oral Suspension accessible to patients through private insurance and public formularies.

About RADICAVA® Oral Suspension (edaravone)

RADICAVA® Oral Suspension is indicated for the treatment of patients with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS).¹ Edaravone was discovered and developed for ALS by Mitsubishi Tanabe Pharma Corporation (MTPC) through an iterative clinical development platform over a 13-year period. In 2015, edaravone was approved for use as a treatment for ALS in Japan and South Korea. RADICAVA® was approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration in May of 2017. Marketing authorization for RADICAVA® IV Infusion was granted in Canada (October 2018), Switzerland (January 2019), Indonesia (July 2020), Thailand (April 2021), and Malaysia (December 2021).

RADICAVA ORS® (edaravone) was approved by the U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA) in May 2022. RADICAVA® Oral Suspension (edaravone) was authorized by Health Canada in November 2022.
